Law Enforcement and Safety: Celebratory Gunfire	PSA campaign	Area advocates and concerned citizens are asking people to be aware of the dangers of celebratory gunfire- firing firearms in the air, since the bullets must fall and land somewhere. In past cases, the bullets have gone through roofs and hurt or killed people.	12/3-1/7	:10, :30 sec 3-5x's daily
Law Enforcement and Safety: Child Abuse Law	PSA campaign	Local advocates are encouraging victims of child sexual abuse to come forward and report their attackers. A new law extends the statute of limitations giving them more time to talk to authorities.	1/1-1/14	:60 sec 3-5x's daily
Law Enforcement and Safety: Don't Drive Buzzed	PSA campaign	State Troopers are warning people about the dangers of even light drinking. It's easy for drivers to get buzzed without knowing how incapacitated they are. Buzzed driving is drunk driving in the law.	1/1-1/7	:60 sec 3-5x's daily
Law Enforcement and Safety: Triple A Tow to Go	PSA campaign	Triple A is offering its "Tow to go" Program to give free safe rides home to people who have had too much alcohol to drink. Rides must come from restaurants, clubs or bars and must be going home.	12/31-1/2	:60 sec 3-5x's daily
Social and Civic: Dante Sipp Needs A Kidney	PSA campaign	22-year old Dante Sipp has a rare kidney disease that has to spend 9 hours a day on dialysis machines to live. He's asking people to become a living donor and give him a kidney.	1/1-1/26	:60 sec 3-5x's daily

Social and Civic: MLK Day of John Lewis	PSA campaign	Congressman John Lewis looks back and gives us an inspirational account of how he got involved with the Civil Rights movement and Dr. Martin Luther King. Social and Civic: MLK Day with Rev. Joseph Lowery	PSA campaign	Civil Rights leader, Rev. Joseph Lowery spoke about the life and legacy of Dr. King. Advocates also encouraged people to honor Dr. King by volunteering in local communities on the King Holiday.	1/9- 1/17	:60 sec 3-5x's daily
Law Enforcement and Safety: Stop Texting and Driving	PSA campaign	Advocates educate drivers about how taking attention from the roads for a few seconds going 55 mph can cause serious damage.	1/7- 1/14	:60 sec 3-5x's daily
Health: Mental Illness Help	PSA campaign	An area psychologist urges people in the African-American community suffering from depression to get help. Many people won't seek help do to the stigma of having mental illness. He gave tips on how to seek help and get inexpensive medications for treatment.	1/27- 2/15	:60 3-5x's daily
Social and Civic: Free Tax Help	PSA campaign	The IRS offers free software called Free File to help voters get their taxes done for free.	1/28- 2/28	:60 sec 3-5x's daily
Health: Blood Pressure is Serious	PSA campaign	High blood pressure can badly damage hearts. People are urged to eat healthy, exercise and get medical help to treat their high blood pressure.	1/28- 2/14	:60 sec 3-5x's daily
Social and Civic: Opportunity Schools District Forum	PSA campaign	The South DeKalb Improvement Association invites the public to get the facts about the Governor's Opportunity School District. Representatives on both sides of the issue debated and answered questions about whether it will help area children. Social and Civic: Early Voting	PSA campaign	People are encouraged to vote in Georgia's Primary to help elect a President that would act favorably to our community. Voters were also asked to vote early.	2/23- 2/26	:30 sec 3-5x's daily
Social and Civic: Teen Talks Summit	PSA campaign	Millions of people fall victim to physical violence and sex trafficking. Teens are especially vulnerable. Georgia has the 3 rd highest rate of teen dating violence in the US. Teens ages 12 to 19 were invited to the Teen Talk Summit to talk about these issue and ways to protect themselves.	2/23- 2/27	:60 sec 3-5x's daily
Law Enforcement and Safety: APD Active Shooter Presentation	PSA campaign	The Atlanta Police Department offered a seminar to teach people how to identify potentially violence situations and how to respond. They'll teach important steps if confronted with a person with a gun to save lives.	2/24- 3/9	:60 sec 3-5x's daily
Social and Civic: Legacy Ball	PSA campaign	Voice Today invited the public to attend the annual Legacy Ball hosted by Vince and Barbara Dooley. Proceeds support outreach programs for Voice Today which works to stop child sexual abuse. According to the FBI, sex trafficking is widespread in Georgia, but Atlanta is one of the largest hubs for sex trafficking.	3/1- 3/5	:30 sec 3-5x's daily
Social and Civic: Heart of a Women Summit	PSA campaign	Greater Community Church of God in Christ invited area women to hear 10 powerful speakers prepared to give messages meant to encourage women to become poised for success. Social and Civic: Clark's Spirit of Greatness Gala	PSA campaign	Clark University recognized its alumni with its Alumni Achievers Spirit of Greatness Gala. During Clark's 150 years, many of their graduates have gone on to shape the history of this county so the school wanted to celebrate these distinguished alumni and their accomplishments.	3/17- 3/19	:60 sec 3-5x's daily

Social and Civic: Caregivers 911 Fashion Show	PSA campaign	This celebrity fashion show featured appearances from area celebrities. The event supports families of seriously ill patients. Social and Civic: Atlanta Children Shelter	PSA campaign	The Atlanta Children's shelter works to provide support for homeless families striving to become self-sufficient. They asked for public support by participating in their "5 to Thrive" 5-k Run and Walk. Social and Civic: Delta Celebration of Women	PSA campaign	The public was invited to celebrate area women of outstanding service and achievement. The ladies of the alumnae chapter of Delta Sigma Theta offered this celebration to honor House Minority leader, Rep. Stacy Abrams; Dr. King's sister, Dr. Christine King Farris and Trumpet Awards Founder, Xernona Clayton. Social and Civic: Congressman David Scott's Jobs Fair	PSA campaign	Congressman Davis Scott held his annual Jobs Fair to assist area people looking for employment. There were also resources available to specially help veterans as well as representatives from the SBA to help area business owners get ahead.
